OBJECTIVES 1

Identify common interest and expectation of member country in The Global Statistical Geospatial Framework (GSGF) in the context of UN-GGIM-AP

Establish agreed work plan and roadmap for sustained application of global statistical framework as a monitoring tool for SDGs

Deliverable:

- 1.Year 1: Drafting work plan and roadmap
- 2.Year 2: Seminar of member of working group to share experiences and best practices
- 3.Year 3: Report of the outcome of seminar and review of the implementation

Method:

- 1.Year 1: Seek cooperation from member country for drafting of plan and roadmap through on-line reviews
- 2.Year 2: Invitations for members to participate in and contribute to the Seminar
- 3.Year 3: Seek input and cooperation of members for the review the check list for the implementation



OBJECTIVES 2

Promote and assist in the application of Global Statistical Geospatial Framework, working with UN-GGIM Expert Group on Integration of Statistical and Geospatial Information

Enhance understanding for sustainable and interoperable GSGF from existing global concepts for Asia Pacific region context, working with Expert Group on Integration of Statistical and Geospatial Information

Deliverable:

1. Year 1: Work in close collaboration with expert group to share information on global guidelines with member countries
2. Year 2: Review work by expert group and other organizations to reflect views of the region
3. Year 3: Finalization on framework

Method:

Coordinate and work closely with members and also with chairs of the expert group on Integration of Statistical and Geospatial Information



OBJECTIVES 3

Conduct pilot projects on Global Statistical Geospatial Framework to enhance the capabilities of National Geospatial Information Agencies

Carry out a pilot project using Global Statistical Geospatial Framework to monitor SDGs achievement in cooperation with National Statistical Agencies

Deliverable:

1. Year 1: Identify countries to carry out pilot projects and draft concept paper
2. Year 2: Carry out study in specified countries. Presentation of Interim report.
3. Year 3: Final report of pilot projects

Method:

Work closely with the fund provider (World Bank) and member countries to identify potential location for carry out the project

Proposed Project: Disaggregation of statistical unit and mapping unit from village level to household level



OBJECTIVES 4

Development of capacity building plan and training at the regional level

Improve the human capacity in areas related to integration of statistical and geospatial information including data collection, standards, institutional framework.

Deliverable:

1. Year 1: Introduction of concept and system of GSGF to develop a capacity model for countries in region
2. Year 2: Selection and application of GSGF in a particular country
3. Year 3: Report on the outcome of the activities

Method:

1. Conduct research on different capacity building tools used globally, especially tool or system within the UN-GGIM Framework
2. Coordinate with members to select country to carry out the application of GSGF
3. Work with focused country to produce outcome of the activities
